



Bendix Core Freight (updated 2/2021)

Bendix pays core freight on one shipment per month that is greater than 500 lbs. or 100 brake shoes, that uses the correct return process. If you ship a minimum of 500 brake shoes, you may make more than one return per month. Brake shoes must be packaged separately from other Bendix products and not be in any type of box. Air disc brakes must be packaged separately from other Bendix products and not be in any type of box. Steering gears should be packaged individually and packaged separately from other Bendix products. Only electronics may be returned in the original packaging. All other cores should be returned in large (not individual) boxes. Please see www.bendixcorefreight.com for additional instructions or email cores@bendix.com.

Bendix Core Return Freight Process

Step 1: Submit your Bendix core return here. You will then receive an email with a copy of the form. Please put a copy of the Bendix core return form on the inside and outside of every pallet, regardless of the destination. This is in addition to the copies provided to the carrier when necessary. This ensures that Bendix will be able to identify your freight if there are any issues while in transit.

Step 2: If your shipment is over 500 lbs. or 100 brake shoes, request a pickup here. You will need a copy of your Bendix core return form to complete this step and you will need to be registered for Ryder Online (ROL). Ryder will then email you a completed Bendix bill of lading. All returns over 500 lbs. must be registered online and shipped using a Bendix bill of lading for each shipment. The destination and carrier are subject to change, do not re-use a previous bill of lading.

By completing this process, the shipment will be tendered to the carrier. The shipper will not need to contact the carrier for pick-up. Use this Bendix bill of lading to ship the material. The carrier will not provide advanced notice for pick-up, material should be ready for transit when the shipment is registered.

Step 3: (Canadian core returns only) As soon as you receive the BOL, send it along with the core return form to canadacores@bendix.com or via fax to 905-856-4523. This is required so that customs documents can be prepared for the shipment to cross the border. Failure to provide the core return documents will delay the shipment and core credit being issued.

Shipments less than 500 lbs. are to be shipped PREPAID to the appropriate address below. Please include a copy of the Bendix core return form that was submitted online following Step 1 above.
